





# Alarm Mode



While the Daily Alarm function is switched on, the alarm sounds for 20 seconds at the preset time each day. Press any button to stop the alarm after it starts to sound. When the Hourly Time Signal is switched on, the watch beeps every hour on the hour. Note that the Daily Alarm and the Hourly Time Signal operate based on the digital time setting

# To set the alarm time

- In the Alarm Mode, hold down © until the hour digits start to flash on the display. The hour digits flash because they are selected.






